The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) allows for minor changes in type design to be approved by a Design Approval Holder (DAH) under a method acceptable to the FAA reference Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR) 21.95. The Fort Worth ACO Branch has developed a process for allowing a DAH to approve minor changes to type design data by way of a Minor Change Agreement (MCA). The goals of this process are to 1) provide DAHs with more timely responses, 2) be a better use of FAA resources, and 3) result in greater standardization in the evaluation and approval of minor changes.

In order to meet 14 CFR 21.95, a MCA must be in place with your company prior to you approving minor changes. We have developed a MCA for your company which references the criteria that you will use to evaluate changes and lists the types of minor changes that do not require FAA involvement. When a minor change to type design follows the process described in the MCA, it is FAA approved and no additional Fort Worth ACO Branch approval is required. I have signed and enclosed the MCA with this letter, please review and sign the agreement as well and return the signed original back to FAA.
